

ADVISOR NOTES ON UA SOUTH RE-PREFIXING

UA South courses do not “transfer.”

Under direction from Jerry Hogle’s office, UA South faculty are working with departments to evaluate courses for an internal UA/UA South equivalency table. This will establish:

- a. direct equivalencies
- b. courses that are not exactly equivalent, but may be close enough so that the catalog and APRRs/SAPRs will use the wording: “Credit will be allowed for only one of the following courses: XYZ 350 or XYZV 350”
- c. courses that are not equivalent. In this case, further instructions will be given regarding how the UA South course will fit into the curriculum.

Until department equivalencies have been determined:

1. Treat UA South courses the same way you did last semester. “Substitutions” will need to be done manually.
2. Watch out for duplicate UA credit, since DARS/SAPRs will not catch students who have taken POL 326 and are now registered for POLV 326 with UA South.
3. Watch out for duplicate transfer courses since DARS/SAPRs will not catch students who have taken PSY 250 at Pima and are now registered for PSYV 360 with UA South.
4. You will frequently see the wording “See also” linking the UA South class with the UA Main class, and vice versa.

Reminder – UA South classes are NOT integrated into the Schedule of Classes. You need to click on “UA South” in the box at the right that says “Other classes.”

Several departments have already completed their equivalencies and these will be noted in the Catalog, Schedule of Classes, APRRs/SAPRs, as soon as possible.
