- Available programs of study differ between campuses. If you are pursuing a major or minor through your current campus
  that is not offered through your intended campus, you will need to change your program of study (unless the program
  requirements are already complete with your previous coursework). To review available majors in the Arizona Online campus,

- If your campus change involves a change of your major, that change must be approved prior to submitting your campus change request. Some majors require a program application that must be approved prior to your campus change. It is important that you speak with an advisor from your intended campus to better understand the pros and cons of changing campuses and the program application process: <a href="https://advising.arizona.edu/advisors/college">https://advising.arizona.edu/advisors/college</a>
- Arizona Online and Distance Network courses are largely offered in accelerated 7.5 week sessions. This format is more
  intensive than a standard semester. It requires students to create balanced schedules with fewer concurrent courses that are
  spread amongst multiple sessions throughout a term. Students can take up to 9 units in a 7.5-week session. In addition to
  online courses, the Distance Network offers some of their courses in traditional face to face, remote, and hybrid formats.
- Before switching your campus, students should ensure that they have access to the necessary technology to be successful. To review recommended computer system requirements and supported browsers, visit <u>https://online.arizona.edu/resources/technical-requirements</u>.
- Tuition rates vary depending on your campus. You are encouraged to review current cost of attendance to determine the best fit for you. - Students can enroll in one campus at a time during a given semester. Students can change campus multiple times throughout their academic journey, as needed or desired. However, the assigned campus cannot be changed *within* a given semester once a student has paid tuition. Campus change requests must be submitted no later than 10 working days before the start of the semester or session.
- The University of Arizona does not provide institutional aid for Arizona Online students. If you currently receive institutional aid then this award will be forfeited if you choose to change campuses into to Arizona Online. Arizona Online programs are eligible for Federal financial aid (such as Pell grants, student loans, and military/VA benefits). Please contact the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid office to discuss any financial aid related questions *before* submitting the campus change request form.
- University of Arizona Honors College programming is not currently available for students in Arizona Online.
- ROTC is not available through in Arizona Online; However, it is available through some of the Distance Network locations if students commute to the Tucson campus.
