8:45 am to 9:00 am: **SSRI - Student Eligibility - Ineligible Status:** Jennifer Ludwig

- Fall 2020 Numbers: 183 Ineligible students, 125 students submitted appeals
 - o 33 met Fast Pass
 - o 92 students sent to committee review
 - o 49 moved back to probation.
 - o 43 stayed as ineligible
- Students who are Ineligible must submit an appeal to stay in classes for future terms.
 - o Students who do not submit an **appeal by 6/4/21**, will have their classes dropped
- What's in the Appeal?
 - o Section 1 – check boxes to provide additional statements about circumstances that led to academic struggles
 - o **No additional documentation is required**
 - o Section 2 – what actions did you take to attempt to regain eligible status
 - o Section 3 – explain your plan moving forward
 - o Section 4 – Does the student have a General Petition submission in process
- How to prepare students
 - o Account holds must be taken care of regardless of appeal approval
 - o If students have submitted a General Petition, this should be included in their statement
 - o GRO's – how will students utilize any remaining GRO's in future terms?
 - o Types of future courses – Are students taking full semester courses or accelerated courses? What is the more appropriate type of courses this student should take
 - o Appeals are holistic reviews of student-produced information, information found in UAccess and Analytics, and Advisor Notes
- University eligibility vs. College eligibility
 - o These are separate – students may remain at the university but they may not be able to continue in their major program or college.
 - Required Program Change

- Questions:
 - o What will happen with summer courses (or courses currently in progress)?
 - Students who are actively taking a course at the time of their

appeal will not be dropped for those current courses. However, students will be removed from all future term courses.

- Can we share Fast-Pass criteria?
 - No, we would prefer all students to thoughtfully prepare their appeals as though Fast-Pass was not available.
- Can advisors add any statements on behalf of a student?
 - No, the reviewers will defer to Advisor Notes for additional information and context to student's experiences. Please complete Advisor Notes!

9:15 am to 9:30 am: **Fostering Success Updates:** Dani Carrillo

- Student eligibility for students:
 - Foster Care/Group Homes
 - Housing Insecurities: Homelessness or Unstable/Unsafe housing
 - Unaccompanied Youth: Under 24, no contacts or care from parents
 - **When in doubt refer to Fostering Success**
- Support
 - Community, financial, food support, mental and physical care, priority registration for classes, employment, housing support, care packages
- How to Refer
 - Email Introduction to Dani (with approval from student):
danicarrillo@arizona.edu
 - If there are any immediate needs
 - Do not promise fixes

- Questions:
 - Are students who were in foster care in AZ and then sent to a different state, under a guardianship w/relatives, eligible for this program?
 - Yes, any state or any foster care
 - Ones that want to return to AZ for college?
 - If they are considered out-of-state there is an additional conversation if it makes sense to continue at the university.
 - Is there a system identifier that advisors can see to indicate students are apart of Fostering Success?
 - There is a student group in Uaccess once they have connected with the office and receive support.
 - Can you or your program help post-trad students who are looking for affordable family housing options? Or can you suggest where best to send these questions?
 - Yes, they do offer support to post-traditional students, but is usually referred outside the university. When indications of need arise, refer to Dani
 - Would they be considered an AZ resident, since they ended up in another state due to circumstances beyond their control? ex: guardianship
 - They must stay in Arizona to qualify for residency especially if they are moved due to foster placement
