


8:45 am to 9:00 am: Orientation and No-Show Policy Updates: Logan Adams

- Countdown to Orientation and Student Preparation for Orientation Day
 - No-Show Confirmation that students must review and agree to policy
 - No-Show Fee will be assessed if they do not attend orientation
 - \$35 Fee
 - Includes info on Gen Ed and Pre-Orientation information
 - Leads to Confirmation of their Major where they may decide to change their orientation
 - Option ends at noon the day prior to their Orientation
 - Pre-Academic Worksheet (PAW) to gather information about students prior education
 - Placement Information
 - Students should access the orientation day meetings through their Next Steps Center

- What is Blue Chip
 - A way to help student engage and experience leadership opportunities
- Helps with retention (5% higher than non-blue chips students)
 - 25% higher FTPT student retention
- Any student is eligible to participate in Blue Chip, does not restrict based on major or campus
- What programs are offered:
 - First Year Experience
 - 1 Credit fall community based course
 - Paired with Mentor
 - For Main Campus students
 - Online courses are available to main campus students
 - Transfer/Continuing Student Experience
 - Students who either are transfer or students who did not participate their first year
 - Not required to take the first year courses

- Online Experience
 - 3 Asynchronous online courses
- New!: Students who complete the full Blue Chip Program will earn a Minor for Leadership Studies and Practice
 - 18-unit minor with 9 units of UD courses
 - Taking 2-6 credits per year
 - Housed in the College of Education
- Program Information
 - Program Fee: \$250 per year
 - Leadership Awards & Need-based fee waiver or payment plans
 - Time Commitment
 - 2-3 hours/week for 1st year students
 - 3-5 hours/week for Transfer/Continuing students
 - Academic Rigor
 - Reflection based for most coursework
- Blue Chip during Orientation
 - Students will be able to meet with Blue Chip staff to get questions answered and/or enrolled
