### Welcome: UPAC Co-Chairs

8:45 am to 8:55 am: Wildcat Way Forward: Annie Kurtin, Devon Thomas, and Ariel Torres

- Available to domestic first year students who have deferred admission for the fall term.
  - Way for students to take courses during the interim between attending main campus.
    - Enroll as non-degree seeking
    - Student are enrolled part-time, up to 9 units total with a minimum of 4 units
      - Student must take EDL 297a 1 unit Special Topics course (success, exploration, and career development focus)
      - Courses mainly Gen Ed.
  - Focus is students who are not able to attend full-time at main campus but do plan to attend either in Spring or next fall
- Advising provided by A-Center
- Costs, Dates and Deadlines provided on Fact Sheet

  - Program fee: \$150
  - Tuition price: \$350/unit
  - Earn a C or better grades/audit courses will be eligible for a \$100/unit rebate
- Merit scholarships cannot be used towards this program
- If students take courses outside of university during deferment they will lose their merit award.

  - Most of staff will remain in remote mode for the fall semester
- New forms online: Change of Schedule & Late Change Petition
  - Forms will be live August 17
  - Paper forms will no longer be accepted
  - Refer to <u>Dates and Deadlines</u> for when students should use the Change of Schedule form
- **IMPORTANT:** Degree Audit Worksheets (DAW) will be available as an online form September 1.
  - Request is to not send any paper DAW until form is live.

- Reghelp is the preferred method to get questions answered
  - If there are specific Microsoft Team groups that the registrar will provide benefit, reach out to registrar with request
- Class schedule and modalities are still in flux, however, they are starting to settle
  - Requests are still coming in for Live Online courses and are being processed as quickly as possible
  - <u>On Ramp</u> class re-entry information is provided in Class Notes area for Inperson or Flex/In-person classes
    - <u>PDF</u> of how this information will appear in Schedule of Classes
- Academic policies have reverted back to original university policies for the fall term.
  - Discussions will continue throughout the semester to make appropriate changes as needed.
- **IMPORTANT:** GRO Deadline is now the last day to Withdraw (W) from classes. Updates to website and policy happening now.
- 9:15 am to 9:30 am: Global Campus Updates: Stephanie Adamson and Lisa Turker
  - Everywhere.arizona.edu Global Direct Pathway in partnership with Arizona Online and Microcampuses
    - Degree Seeking and Non-Degree Seeking options
    - Undergraduate and Graduate offerings
    - The intent is to have student eventually transition to main campus or use credits towards transferring to another university
      - Majority of students are the main campus transition intent
    - Continuing students can switch into Global Direct, however, most of the courses are for incoming new students, lower-division courses
      - Some courses are co-convened with main campus courses
    - <u>globalcampus@arizona.edu</u> for change of campus to Global Direct for **continuing** students (sophomore and up)
  - Global direct can accommodate students if they decide to continue beyond the Fall term.
    - May transition into a fully online degree program
    - May continue into the Spring semester, if needed
  - Cost: \$500 per unit
    - Scholarships are available for students to help off-set cost (Global Direct Campus only)
