FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What will I gain from participating in this program?

Mentees will gain knowledge on how to navigate everything from college to career to personal experiences. Mentors will enable them to build their professional connections, strengthen their Arizona alumni network, and create deep, meaningful mentormentee relationships.

What training is involved?

Our mentors' commitment to creating a safe and inclusive environment is of utmost importance. Before mentors and mentees begin meeting, they will participate in in-depth training to cover campus resources, Step Up! Bystander Intervention Training and Safe Zone training.

What are the mentorship meetings like?

Through confidential conversations, mentors and mentees spur personal growth through active listening and asking thought-provoking questions. We encourage everyone to offer advice and share perspectives in this group-learning environment.

How much time is required?

Mentors and mentees are asked to participate in monthly one-hour conversations for seven months (October-April). This time commitment, along with any needed individual follow-up, permits mentors and mentees to form a lasting professional relationship.

What if the mentorship relationship isn't working out for me?

Throughout the process, we will collect feedback on the mentorship and ensure the mentors and mentees feel supported. We will require both mentors and mentees to agree to maintain confidentiality but we are here to help if problems arise.
